This project focuses on sustainable building practices by offering Net-Zero Micro-Credentials for community leadership and decision-makers, and the Net-Zero Home Builder for Indigenous Trades Professionals Program. By taking part in these programs, communities will enhance leadership capacity, boost professional skills, and work toward long-term sustainability through eco-friendly housing solutions. One of the key opportunities is the chance to have a **Net-Zero home** built in a qualifying community, providing tangible benefits in energy efficiency, environmental impact, and housing resilience.
